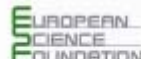

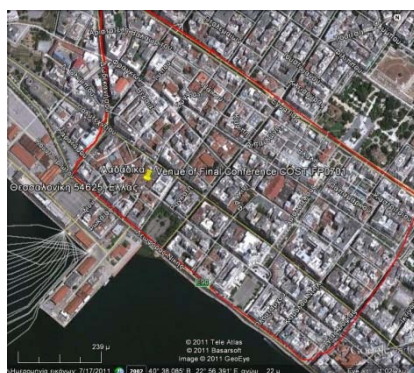

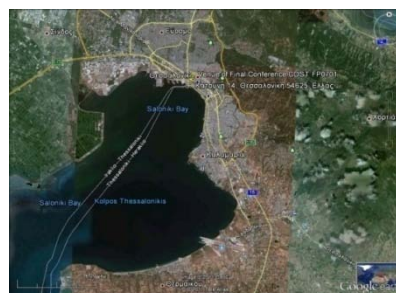


The conference venue is located in the centre of the city
